Menus:

Our menus change weekly. We are not using our traditional dine in menus. You can find the links for our menus on our website home page and on the menus page. We always have the top sellers such as the Tomato Pie, Quiche, Chicken Salad and Burgers at lunch and Hamburger Steak, Smothered Chicken etc at dinner. Our brunch items are now offered a la carte instead of as a sampler. Very seldom do we ever run out of the favorites but it would be wise if you know you are craving something especially Filet Mignon or Salmon to request we reserve the item for you. We update our menus daily based on what is available. Wildflower has had to limit its menu since it has had to cut back hours and seating capacity. We are doing our best to keep the business alive and well and create amazing food and experiences.

Reservations:

Seating is at half capacity as a result we are filling up faster. We highly suggest reservations before coming but they are not required. You can make your reservation on Open Table. If you have a party of more than 6 you will need to call the cafe for reservations so we can help you because there is very little space for larger groups. (256) 634-0066 We are hopeful that reservations will help us with social distancing. Wildflower is asking that if you have a large party that one or only a few in the party check in with the host and when the table is ready the rest of the party comes in especially if you see that the Cafe looks busy. Take out, Curbside & Outdoor Dining:

Wildflower is happy to accommodate take out and offer curbside. Curbside to us means that you call your order in and then when you arrive we can bring a device to the porch entrance or take exact cash so you do not have to come inside. Take out is either calling the order in or coming inside to place the order and paying indoors. Our outdoor dining is take out or curbside. No Reservations for outdoor dining. The cold temps do not make it ideal though we have some moderate and sunny days on the horizon. We have tables and chairs under our tent and on our lawn. The heat in our tent is very minimal so we suggest bundling up and/or bringing a blanket. It is more of a picnic experience because we do not have a server available for table service to do things like refills, etc. There are also picnic tables at Mentone Area parks. We are looking into delivery for 2021.

Mask Requirement:

Wildflower employees that come in contact with guests are wearing masks. We have a sign on the door that says masks are required though we can not legally ask a guest why they are not wearing a mask. So far about 90% of guests have complied with the requirement.

What you can expect indoors?

Wildflower is still serving the best quality and tasting food it has for 13 years. The servers are now taking payment at the table after the meal so we can limit the amount of people gathering in the lobby. The delicious food & drink that is served will be on disposable plates, bowls and cups as required by the health department for Wildflower. We hope to serve you an amazing experience soon.
